Flourish, Kansas City's furniture bank, partners with social service agencies providing wrap-around services to empower families overcoming housing insecurity.

By collecting, repairing, and providing donated furniture and home essentials for the entire home, Flourish impacts lives.



Flourish began in 2009 as My Father's House, an outreach of Church of the Resurrection. The founder, a former employee of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, recognized that families transitioning out of homelessness were moving into and living in unfurnished spaces.

By connecting individuals who have overcome housing insecurity with donated home goods, he created a bridge between abundance and need.

For the next ten years, we developed a network of community partnerships and a dedicated volunteer base, allowing us to serve more and more individuals each year. To expand our impact beyond the support of the church, we became an independent 501(c)(3) charity in late 2019, becoming the organization you know today as Flourish, a furniture bank.



Many of our volunteers have served at Flourish since the very beginning, giving thousands of hours in volunteer service on behalf of our Kansas City neighbors in need, ensuring nobody sleeps on the floor and everyone has a table at which to eat.

"Not long ago, I found myself in a situation I never thought I'd experience - Homelessness. Life had thrown me a series of curveballs, and before I knew it, I was without a place to call home. The days were long, the nights even longer, and the struggle to keep hope alive was one of the hardest battles I've had to face. But I refused to give up. I knew that if I kept pushing forward and asked for help, I could turn things around. Slowly but surely, I began to get back on my feet, and eventually, I was able to secure a place of my own for the first time in five years for me and my five year old son, Roman.

As much of a victory as that was, the reality hit me when I walked through the door; it was empty. No furniture, no comfort, mothing to make it feel like a real home. After everything I'd overcome, this felt like another mountain to climb. Thats when Flourish stepped in and changed everything. They helped me furnish my apartment, provided me with the essentials I needed. From a couch to sleep on to a table to eat my meals, they turned an empty space into a home. It's hard to put into words just how much that meant to me. For the first time in a long time, I could sit down in my own space and feel a sense of comfort, peace, and dignity."

ADMINISTRATIVE Flourish has many administrative duties that are done at the by warehouse or remote volunteers. Calling guests, data entry, writing thank you notes, sending out daily worksheets, and more. Interested in volunteering from home? We may have a job for you!

Have an eye for design or color? Flourish is looking for creative volunteers who can pack sets of art our guests! Browse selection of donated inventory and curate a set of artwork and decor to be packed into Art Packs.

Volunteers in our Beds department beds, together mattress donations, and make sure that each guest receives a clean bed and frame for the best night's sleep

Our dish packers take mismatched donated dishes and create artfully curated and coordinated sets out of available inventory.

DOCK WORKERSOur Dock Workers are in charge of ensuring each box and piece of furniture is carefully loaded in to guest's vehicle. They also accept incoming donations and work with the pickers, packers, and bed team, to ensure all items are loaded and ready to go.

DRIVERS AND ASSISTANTSPerfect for folks with flexible weekday schedules! Help us get picked up, donations deliver furnishings to homes, and make other important runs. Most shifts are only 1-4 hours and offer flexibility.

Our estate sale team is a group of volunteers that clean out sales they are completed. Volunteers can pack boxes of small items, load furniture, or take inventory.

Our electrical testers inspect and when needed and possible, repair Work in our Sewing Department incoming donations so they are in like new working condition for our families coming in to shop.

Staff a table or booth at a local event! This is a great way to meet new people and introduce them to Flourish. Hand out flyers, share information about Flourish, and invite attendees to join our Newsletter list.

The Floor Captain is a volunteer role that involves answering phones and emails, greeting and checking in guests, and doing light paper and One of the biggest jobs at Flourish, computer work.
